Long Ashton Golf Club is looking forward to welcoming the region's premier amateur golfers for the Ashton Vase event. The Club is proud to host the first of each season's Duchess Salver events and tries to present the course in the best condition possible.

But, over the last few years, the Club has occasionally been disappointed by the behavior of a very few individuals, who have appeared to be insensitive to the fact that the course is closed to Club members.

The Club would like to take this opportunity to state clearly its dress code for this event, which is considered to be both reasonable and entirely consistent with the "GGU Players Charter"

When applying for entry, applicants need to sign to confirm that they have read and accept the conditions. Anyone who is considered to be in breach of them may be asked to leave the Club's premises immediately without refund of entry fees and may not be welcome for future events.

Conditions of Entry to 2017 Competition

Anyone who needs to withdraw from the competition after the draw-sheet is published, or who is unable to complete both rounds of the competition, should notify the Club's General Manager immediately and also write to the Club to give a full explanation.

The following items of clothing are not permitted on the course.

- Collarless and/or sleeveless shirts,
- Rugby or football shirts
- Shorts must be tailored and not cargo style with external pockets

Golf Shoes must be worn when playing.

In the clubhouse, the following items of clothing are not acceptable:

- Headwear of any sort,
- Denim Jeans
- Trainers
- Outdoor coats, jackets or trousers,
- Any clothing used on the course which is wet or dirty.

Additional conditions:

- Footwear and socks must be worn at all times,
- Footwear or clothing must not be changed anywhere other than in the dressing rooms,
- Shirts must be tucked into the waistband at all times,
- Mobile phones must not be used on the course or in the clubhouse.
- Prize-winners are expected to stay for the prize-giving ceremony at the conclusion of play,
- Foul language is completely unacceptable,
- Normal golf etiquette should be followed at all times. Behaviour towards other competitors and members and staff of the Club should be respectful.
